Useful Information

Public transportation. We recommend to buy a 7-day ticket for fare zone 1. This allows you to use all metros, buses, trams and ferries in the central part of Oslo. The ticket costs 335 kr. The app “Ruter” is the most convenient way to buy (all kinds of) tickets. Note that there are no ticket machines at the stations and you cannot buy tickets on board the metro/bus/tram/ferry.

Wifi. You can either use Eduroam or the network “uioguiest”. The latter requires you to register with (and confirm) your phone number first.

This requires taking the bus to “Solvikveien”, which is outside of fare zone 1. Therefore, you need to buy an additional ticket even if you own a 7-day ticket for the city center.
